

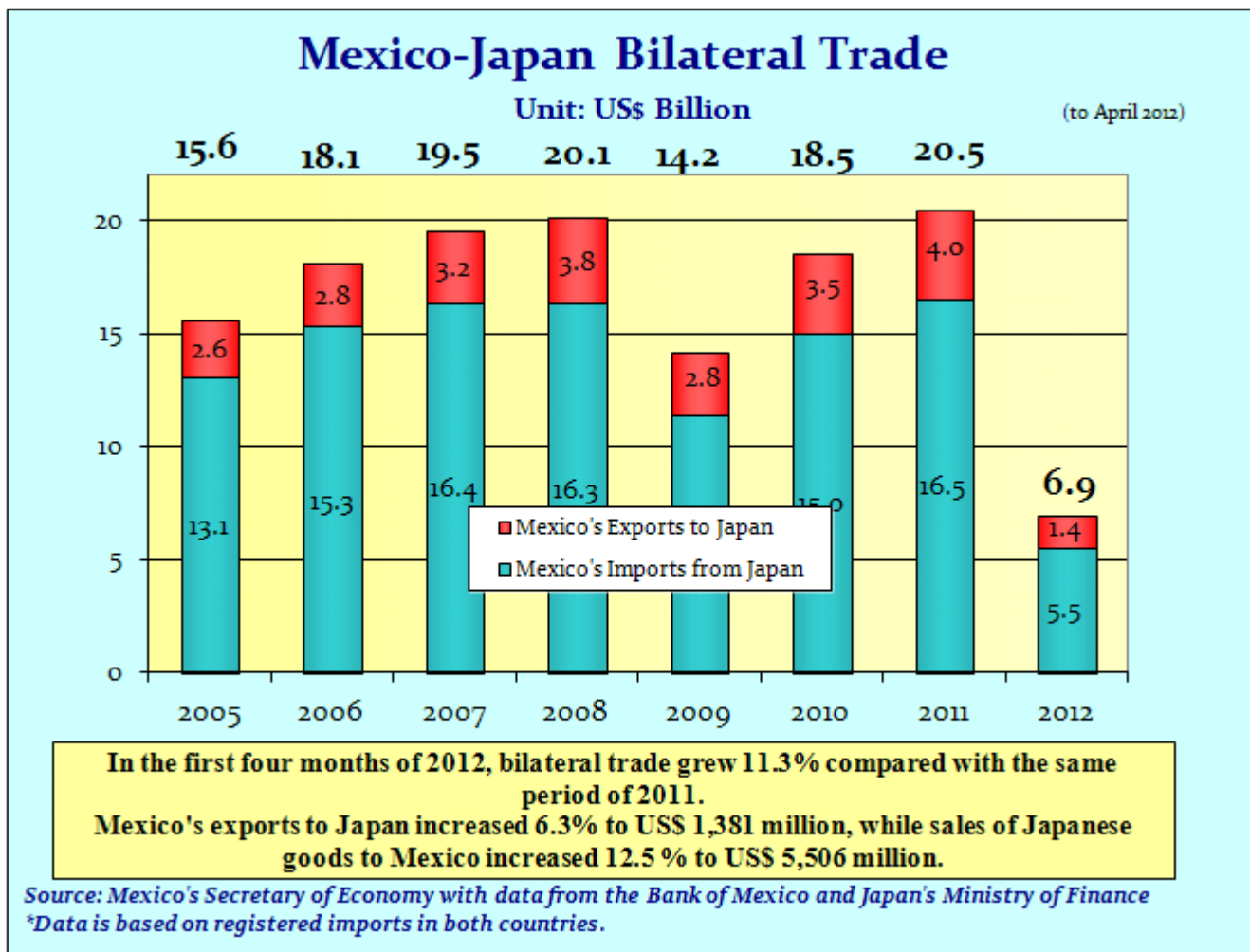
Mexico-Japan Trade Statistics

With data to April 2012

Trade in goods between Japan and Mexico maintains its positive performance expanding at double digits during the January-April 2012 period. The value of bilateral trade accumulated for the year reached almost US\$ 6.9 billion, an increase of 11.3% over the same period of last year.

Mexico's exports to Japan reached US\$ 1,381 million, posting a 6.3% growth during the period. The main products exported to Japan are agricultural products, finished vehicles, machinery, electronic components, insulated wire and cable, scientific and optical instruments, chemicals, and commodities.

Japanese sales to Mexico were US\$ 5,506 million during the first four months of 2012, an increase of 12.5% from the same period of last year. Main Japanese products sent to Mexico include auto parts, finished vehicles, precision tools and instruments, and electronic boards.
