The EPA has established duty free import quotas for the Japanese market to the following Mexican products:

- Honey
- Fresh Bananas
- Fresh Oranges
- Orange Juice (fresh and frozen)
- Agave Syrup
- Tomato Juice
- Ketchup
- Tomato Sauce
- Processed Tomatoes for making Ketchup
- Sorbitol
- Dextrin
